This includes 200 *GM ATLAS*™ systems featuring jackpot progressives, as well as blackjack and poker derivatives, to provide exciting and enhanced gaming experiences for all types of travelers.

"This innovative technology allows us to link gaming experiences across our vessels, offering our guests even more excitement and the opportunity for larger payouts."

Current Light & Wonder titles installed include Blackjack, *LET IT RIDE*™, *THREE CARD POKER*™ and *ULTIMATE TEXAS HOLD 'EM*™, with all games contributing to one progressive among all tables and all ships. Light & Wonder's first progressive system installation as part of this collaboration occurred on the Norwegian Breakaway in August 2024, with additional installations underway.
