“Light & Wonder’s table games technology supports our operational objectives across a diverse portfolio of properties,” said Jeffrey Taips, Chief Operating Officer for Delaware North’s Gaming business, now Ember Entertainment. “This agreement provides a consistent, scalable approach to managing table operations.”
